



THE RULES

Players: 4-8
Ages: 14+

INTERIOR: YOUR LIVING ROOM – NIGHT
Gather around a humble coffee table to spin the wheel of fate with **CASTING CALL!** As friends and family transform into skilled thespians, your home becomes a Hollywood battlefield with merciless actors clawing their way onto the silver screen!



CONTENTS (90 CARDS):

30 Screenplay Cards:
Your script for the auditions.
Give it all you've got!





20 Callback Cards:
Refine your performance based on the genre and action on the card. You're one step closer to landing the role. This is your opportunity to show your range!








20 "Do You Know Who I Am?" Cards:
These are wild cards – using them can make all the difference. Play yours strategically to get ahead, take out your competition, and win that part!



20 Star Cards:
This is your reward for landing the part.  
Collect three to find fame and fortune and win the game!

OBJECT OF THE GAME:

The object of the game is to become a movie star!
Collect three Star Cards to win the game.   
Get ready for your close-up; you're about to be the next big thing!  

PREPARATION:

- One player separates and shuffles each of the four stacks of cards.
1. Place each pile face down on the table.
 2. Deal one **Do You Know Who I Am?** Card to each player.

GAME PLAY:

Players read their **Do You Know Who I Am?** Cards, but **keep them secret** until played! These cards may use them now or at **ANY TIME** during the game.

In each round, one person plays the **DIRECTOR**. Everyone else is an **ACTOR** auditioning for a role. Whoever saw a movie in a theater most recently is the Director for the first round.

STEP 1 – The Audition

The Director draws a **Screenplay Card** and chooses one of the two dialogue lines for the Actors to perform.

The person to the left of the Director auditions first. After the Actor gets into character and signals they're ready, the Director calls "Action!" and the Actor gives their best performance! Then they pass the card to the Actor on their left, who performs their own take on the same line. This continues until each Actor has auditioned.

Flub your line? Don't fret. If an Actor wants to try again, they may say "Take 2" and repeat their performance.

STEP 2 – The Callback

Time to narrow the field! The Director selects their two top performances, then picks a **Callback Card** from the deck. Choosing one of the two adjustments provided, the Director reads the instructions to the two chosen Actors. Then it's go time! Using the same script, the Actors give the performance of their lives.

STEP 3 – The Star Card

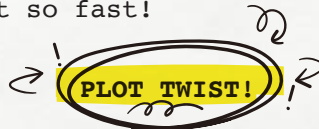
The Director now casts ONE of the two Actors to star in their new movie and presents the Actor with a **Star Card** from the deck.

The Actor reads the card out loud to learn their fate. Was their agent able to close their deal? Or did a film's financing go bust before the cameras ever rolled? Anything can happen on the set of a movie!



THIS ROUND IS OVER, but the game continues until someone collects three **Star Cards**. The person to the left of the Director becomes the new Director, and casting starts again.

Sounds simple, right? Not so fast!



This is Hollywood, sweetheart! From the penthouse to the outhouse in a split second! Play your **Do You Know Who I Am?** Card at **ANY TIME** during the game. Slap down one of these babies and you might be able to grab someone's **Star Card**, or even horn in on their callback audition! One thing is certain, you'll cackle with glee at the absolute unfairness of it all!

NOTE: If awarded a **Star Card** from a **Do You Know Who I Am?** Card, **DO NOT READ THE BACK OF THE STAR CARD. THIS IS A REWARD CARD ONLY.** Star Card instructions only come into play when an Actor receives them from the Director after landing a role.

All cards once played are returned to the bottom of their respective decks.

WINNING THE GAME:

The first player to collect **THREE STAR CARDS** achieves movie-star status and wins the game! All that's left is to write your awards ceremony acceptance speech, filled with false modesty and fake gratitude! We know, you couldn't have done it without us.
